Definitions

Abstract — an artwork that is comprised of shapes and colors

Supplies

Paper Masking Tape Markers, Color Pencils, or Crayons

Directions

1. First, take strips of masking tape and stick them across your paper, crossing the pieces on top of each other.

Next, color in the areas in between your strips of masking tape. You can use crayon, color pencils, markers.

3. Lastly, you can peel off the tape to reveal your colored shapes. Feel free to leave the tape on or color the lines if you'd prefer!
