Kendall Shaw is a local artist and pioneer of the Pattern and Decoration movement, which incorporates color, shape, and rhythm with musical influences. He acquired international praise for his patterned paintings. Experiment with line and repetition to create patterned artwork of your own.

Supplies List:

Tape, Markers, Cardboard: 4 squares of varying size, Colored Paper, Glue sticks

Instructions:

Step 1: Pick out 4 different size cardboard pieces and decide how you want to layer them.

Step 2: Choose different colors of paper. Cut and glue the paper, covering 1 side of the cardboard.

Step 3: Use markers to create a pattern with dots. Fill the cardboard with your pattern. Try to create a different pattern on each layer.

Step 4: Use tape to attach and layer the 4 pieces together in order to create depth.
