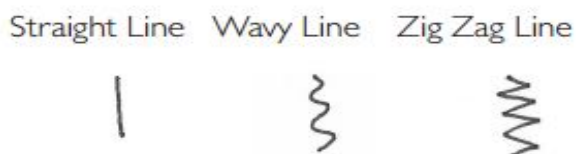


Ogden After Hours

Supplies List:

Permanent markers, Washable markers, Paintbrush, Cardstock

Instructions:

Step 1: Think about your favorite animal. What shapes or lines make up the animal?

Step 2: Use the motifs below and a permanent marker to draw your animal and its environment.

Step 3: Color your nature scene using washable markers.

Step 4: Use water and a paintbrush to “paint” your nature scene.
