Create a narrative collage about the characters in the photographs. Where are they and what are they doing?

Supplies List:

Colored pencils, Glue,
Scissors, Cardstock

Instructions:

Step 1: Pick out your favorite photographs.

Step 2: Use scissors to cut out the characters.

Step 3: Think about where your characters are and what they are doing.

Step 4: Draw a background for your characters using colored pencils.

Step 5: Use a glue stick to glue your characters onto your background.

Step 6: On the back of your collage write a story about your characters.
