



## Ogden After Hours O-riginal Art Activity: Pattern Collage Inspired by Walter Anderson

### Supplies List:

Markers, Glue, Cardstock,  
Scissors

### Instructions:

**Step 1:** Pick your favorite animal from the templates.

**Step 2:** Using a marker and the motifs below draw details on the animals.

**Step 3:** Use scissors to cut out the animals.

**Step 4:** Use a glue stick to glue your animals to the paper. Think about pattern, repetition and balance when arranging the animals.

**Step 5:** Draw an environment for your animals to live in.
