Instructions

Step 1: Decide if you want to make a self-portrait or a **portrait** of a friend or family member.

Step 2: Explore your house. Look for materials that you can use to create a portrait. Think about the colors and textures of the materials you collect. What is the color and texture of your hair, what materials can you use to re create that? Make sure you ask a parent or guardian's permission to use the materials that you find.

Step 3: Once you have collected materials for your artwork find a place to set up your assemblage. You can create your artwork on a piece of paper, on the floor, or on a table.

Step 4: Think about how you want to arrange the materials to create your artwork. What are the colors and textures of the materials that you have collected? How can you use these characteristics to re-create the characteristics within your portrait?

Step 5 (Optional): Take a picture of your artwork and share with your friends and family.

Vocabulary

Found object — a thing that someone else has given or thrown away that is often repurposed by artists

Portrait — an image of a person; genre of art
